In Consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant permission to The Detroit Edison Company, its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least four (4) feet, upon, over and across our property located in Section thirty four (34) Milford Twp.

Street and Village Section and Township
County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows: One hundred forty acre tract in the southeast quarter of Section thirty four (34).

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Along north of and adjacent to the northerly side line of the Grand Trunk Railroad from the south line of said property to the highway running along the east line of Section thirty four (34). Also a spur running southerly from gravel plant to G.T.R. and a spur running easterly from the gravel plant to the highway. The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property. This agreement supersedes a similar agreement bearing date of April 23, 1910.
