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In Consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, WE hereby grant permission to **The Detroit Edison Company**, its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least Six (6) feet, upon, over and across our property located in Township of Milford
Street and Village or Section and Township
County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section thirteen (13) T. 2 N. R. 7 E.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Along parallel to and forty three (43) feet north of the angle running northwest by southeast across said land.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Two and 00/100 Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
