which is hereby acknowledged I hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stube, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least six (6) feet, upon, over and across

property located in Township of Milford

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as

follows: The Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Thirteen (13) Town 2 North, Range 7 East.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Along, parallel to and 33 feet North-easterly of the center line of the angling road running Northwesterly by Southeasterly across the Southwest corner of the above described land.

The Company shall reimburse me for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.
