RIGHT OF WAY FILE No. 8229

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IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations,

receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant permission to **THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY**, its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least eight (8) feet, upon, over and across our property located in the Township of Milford County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: The north ten (10)

acres of the east half of the southeast quarter of section twenty-four (24) in Township two (2) north of range seven (7) east, excepting therefrom the north twenty (20) feet thereof deeded to Augustus J. Helcomb for purposes of a right of way
The route of the lines shall be as follows:

Permission is hereby given for one **ERRED TO** pole as is now set in the northeast corner of said land

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Three and 00 (\$3.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected. receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
