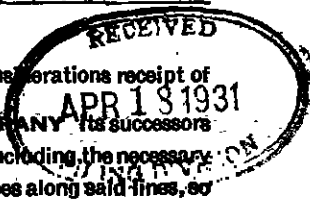

**IN CONSIDERATION** of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations receipt of which is hereby acknowledged W.E. hereby grant permission to **THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY** its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least six feet, upon, over and across out property located in Village of Milford STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows: Lots # 57, 58, 59 and 60 of Meek's Addition.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Along and adjacent to the south line of said lots.
