IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations,

receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its line electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to

trim any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least six feet, upon our property located in Township of Milford of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

COUNTY OF OAKLAND

The northeast quarter of the northwest quarter and the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of section 16, T. 2 N. R. 7 E.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Along, parallel to and sixty (60) to eighty (80) feet south of the south highway fence around willow trees along highway. Both corner poles and anchors shall be in north and south fence lines and no other anchors shall be set in field.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Fifty and 00/100 Dollars for said right of way on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
