IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, me hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines of electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including the right to trim any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least 10 feet, upon, over and across my property located in Village of Milford of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: Lot #10 of Assessors Replat of Bellevue Addition of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 10, T 2 N, R 7 E.

NOV 14 1931

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Overhang of wires along and adjacent to the West line of said land and anchors and guys along the South line not more than 50' from the West line.

The Company shall reimburse me for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.

~~In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay me the sum of _____ Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.~~

RELEASE OF RIGHT OF WAY

THIS INSTRUMENT, made this 9th day of April A.D. 1958 between THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY a New York corporation with its principal office at 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit 26, Michigan, hereinafter called "EDISON" and LARGO HOMES, a Michigan co-partnership of 13825 Fenkell Avenue, Detroit, Michigan, hereinafter referred to as "LARGO", and KENSINGTON HILLS DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, a Michigan co-partnership of 300 American Title Building, Detroit 26, Michigan, hereinafter referred to as "KENSINGTON".

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, On June 4, 1951, A. J. GOLATA and HILDA A. GOLATA, his wife, and JAMES F. BUTLER and ELIZABETH S. BUTLER, his wife, and HAZEL K. BIRD ELLSWORTH, granted to EDISON, a right of way recorded on June 22, 1951 in Liber 2754, Pages 269 and 270, Oakland County Records, for the purpose of constructing, operating, and maintaining its lines for electric light and power upon, over and across premises located in the Village of Milford, Oakland County, Michigan and described as follows:

Lot 10 of Assessor's replat of Bellevue addition to the Village of Milford, part of the southeast 1/4 of the southeast 1/4 of Section 10, Town 2 North, Range 7 East; and

WHEREAS, on July 10, 1931, HAZEL K. RICHARDSON granted to EDISON a similar easement over said Lot 10, which easement was recorded in Liber 33 of Miscellaneous Records, Pages 207 and 208, Oakland County Records; and

WHEREAS, LARGO purports to have succeeded to that portion of the premises described above, which portion is described as follows:

Lots 16 to 23 inclusive and Lot 32, Amended Kensington Hills Subdivision No. 1, of part of the southeast 1/4 of Section 10 and of part of the northeast 1/4 of Section 15, Town 2 North, Range 7 East, according to the Plat thereof as recorded in Liber 93, Page 15 of Plats, Oakland County Records, which Subdivision is a replat, part of said Lot 10 of Assessor's replat of Bellevue addition to the Village of Milford; and

WHEREAS, KENSINGTON purports to have succeeded to the title to that portion of said Lot 10 described above which is not vested in LARGO as set forth above; and

WHEREAS, LARGO and KENSINGTON have requested that EDISON release said Lot 10 from the above mentioned Right of Way Grant dated June 4, 1951, and the above mentioned Right of Way Grant dated July 10, 1931.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations paid to EDISON by LARGO and KENSINGTON, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, EDISON does by these presents expressly release and abandon unto LARGO and KENSINGTON, insofar as their purported interests are concerned as set forth above, all of the rights acquired by it under the aforementioned Rights of Way Grants dated June 4, 1951 and July 10, 1931.
