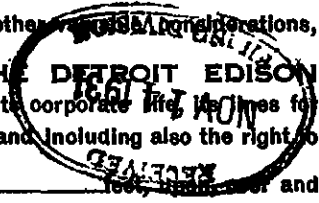

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other ~~considerations~~, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, WE hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least feet and across our property located in Village and Township of Milford County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: That part of the south-east quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 10 lying south of the General Motors Road and west of the Milford-New Hudson Road. and that part of the north half of the northwest quarter of Section 15 lying west of the Milford-New Hudson Road. All in T 2 N, R 7 E.



The route of the lines shall be as follows: In an easterly and westerly direction along and adjacent to the line between Sections 10 and 15. And in a northerly and southerly direction along approximately two rods east of and parallel to the north and south eighth line in the south-west quarter of Section 10.

The Company shall reimburse US for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay US the sum of Three and no/100-(3.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
