IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration

receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to or cut trim any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least eight (8) feet, upon our and across our property located in Township of Milford County

of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: Lands in the north part of the west half of the east half of the northeast quarter of Section 9 bounded on the south by lands of Frank H. Alfred, and that part of the west half of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 4 lying south of the Milford-Brighton Road, containing in all thirty six (36) acres, more or less, and all in T 2 N, R 7 E.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northerly and southerly direction across said lands along approximately fifty (50) feet west of east line at north line and approximately ten (10) feet west of east line at south line of said lands.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of (3100) Three and 100/100 Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
