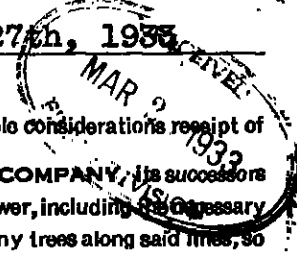

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations receipt of

which is hereby acknowledged I hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including all necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stabs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least six (6) feet, upon, over and across my property located in Township of Milford

County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

That part of the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Sec. 10, T 2 N., R 7 E. covered by the Mill pond and the Huron Dam and Power House and bounded south and west by lands of Frank Alfred. Also, a strip of land approximately one rod wide along the west side of the east half of the southwest quarter of Sec. 10, T 2 N., R 7 E. extending north from the General Motors Road to the Mill Pond.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Along the west side of lane from General Motors Road to Mill Pond; thence west along south line of land to a point opposite south end of dam; thence across Dam to west line of land; thence north along westline of land, as now staked by the Com

This agreement supercedes and renders null and void a certain similar agreement dated October 27th, 1931.

The Company shall reimburse me for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.
