which is hereby acknowledged we hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least ten (10) feet, upon, over and across our property located in Township of Malford

County of Oakland STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP State of Michigan, and described as follows: The southwest 1/4 of the northeast 1/4 of section 16, T. 2 N. R. 7 E.

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The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northwesterly and southeasterly direction across said land approximately one hundred fifty (150) feet north of West Commerce Road.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.
