The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a Northwesterly and Southeasterly direction across said land approximately 150 feet North of and parallel to West Commerce Road, so called.

The Company shall reimburse owner for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.
