IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, WE hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across OUR property located in CITY OF WALLED LAKE

County of OAKLAND State of Michigan, and described as follows:
LOT 4 - OF SUPERVISORS PLAT # 4 BEING PART OF THE WEST 1/2 SECTION 26, PART OF SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SOUTHEAST 1/4 SEC 27, AND PART OF NORTHEAST 1/4 SECTION 34 AND PART OF THE NORTH WEST 1/4 SECTION 35 ALL IN TOWN 2 NORTH RANGE 8 EAST. IN Liber 54A PAGES 79 & 79A OF PLATS

The route of the lines shall be as follows: ANCHORS IN AN EASTWARD AND WESTWARD DIRECTION, ALONG AND ADJACENT TO THE NORTH LINE

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of FIVE & NO/100 \$5.00 Dollars ABOVE on said land, the same to be paid before any wires are erected.
