IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, We hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary towers, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in CITY OF PONTIAC

STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of OAKLAND, State of Michigan, and described as follows: Part of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 10, T3N, R10E, described as commencing at the W 1/4 corner of said Sec. 10; thence N 89°21' E on E and W 1/4 section line 1007.0 ft; thence S 0°39' E 1434.84 ft to the point of beginning of this description; thence N 88°12' E 853.13 ft; thence S 1°56' E 200.0 ft; thence S 88°12' W 857.15 ft; thence N 12°03' W 2.42 ft; thence N 0°39' W 197.62 ft to the point of beginning, containing 3.93 acres, except an easement of 30 ft off the Easterly side of above description and an easement of 30 ft off the Westerly side of above description to be used for public roads and utilities.

The route of the lines shall be as follows:

In a Northerly and Southerly direction across said land along and adjacent to the West Eighth line of said Section 10.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay us the sum of One hundred and no (100) Dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected or twenty five dollars (\$25) for overhang of wires
