IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we heroby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary towers, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in

CITY OF PONTIAC

STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows: Part of the SW 1/4 and the SE 1/4 of Section 15, Town 3 North, Range 10 East, Township of Pontiac, Oakland County, Michigan, described as ~~beginning at the center of Section 15, thence N. 88°12' W. 638 ft, thence S 50 ft to the NE'ly right of way line of the Belt Line Railroad; thence SE'ly along said right of way on a curve to right, having a radius of 1,835.08 ft, a central angle of 38°55'50" a long chord of 1,233.0 ft with bearing of S 29°21'30" E; thence around said curve a distance of 1,237.71 ft to the NW'ly line of Perry Street; thence N 55°53'30" E along Perry Street 46.0 ft to the N and S 1/4 line; thence N along said 1/4 line 676.56 ft; thence E 115.32 ft to the center-line of Giddings Road; thence N ~~thence N 38°54'30" W along the center line of Giddings Road 183.13~~ ft to the N and S 1/4 line; thence N along said 1/4 line 251 ft to the point of beginning.~~

The route of the line shall be as follows: Along Northeasterly of and adjacent ^{to} the Northeasterly right of way line of the Grand Trunk Western Belt Line Railroad across said land.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay us the sum of One hundred & 00/100 (\$100) Dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected.
