IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, We hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary towers, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in \_\_\_\_\_

County of OAKLAND, State of Michigan, and described as follows: Lots 11 and 12 of Assessor's Plat 146 of part of the E 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 15, T3N, R10E, according to the plat thereof as recorded in Liber 35 of Plats, page 41, Oakland County Records and part of the E 1/2 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 15, described as follows: Beginning at a point at SW corner of Lot 2, Assessor's Plat 146 of part of the E 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 15, said point being located S 88°11'45" W 1173.52 ft and S 2°12'15" E 685.3 ft from the N 1/4 corner of Sec. 15; thence from this point as place of beginning S 2°12'15" E 192.41 ft; thence S 89°15'20" W 149.43 ft; thence N 2°12'15" W 192.41 ft; thence N 89°15'20" E 149.43 ft to point of beginning.

The route of the lines shall be as follows:

Along East of and adjacent to the West lines of above described lands.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay us the sum of One hundred & no/100 (\$100) Dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected. Or twenty five dollars (25) for overhang of wires
