IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, We hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary towers, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in _____

STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of OAKLAND, State of Michigan, and described as follows: The Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 3, T3N, R10E, excepting therefrom a parcel of land described as beginning at a point in the North and South Quarter line distant North 420 feet from the center of said Section 3; thence North along the North and South Quarter line 566.73 feet; thence W 773.34 feet; thence South 0°56'10" East 566.80 feet; thence East 736.91 feet to the point of beginning, containing 10 acres of land.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Along East of and adjacent to the West line of said land.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay us the sum of One hundred dollars (100) Dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected.
