

The property in question – partial release on the Bloomfield-Sunbird 120-kV tower line West of Giddings Road. The easement width is 90' with 45' on each side of the center line of the tower line. An additional 30' on each side of the 90' wide easement to cut and trim trees.

- 1. The grade level cannot be altered within the easements.

You requested a partial release of an Edison Towerline easement located in the NW ¼ of Section 3, City of Auburn Hills, Oakland County, Michigan. The easement was granted to Edison by Lavonne D. and Jos. Mouw on March 6, 1948 and recorded in liber 2248 page 124.

Edison requires at least 150 feet in width (75 feet on each side of the centerline of the towers) for this towerline easement. We are currently confirming the location of your property in relation to the towers. As long as your property is more than 75 feet away from the towers, Edison will release the tower easement as it pertains to your property only.

Additionally, Edison has various other easements located on the property. Since we currently have equipment in the easements, we must retain them. If the equipment is relocated according to MPSC rules and at your cost, Edison will release those easements.
