STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

Lot # 14 of Malkin Farms a subdivision of part of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 16, Town 3 North, Range 10 East, as recorded in Liber 55, page 50, of Oakland County records.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In an easterly and westerly direction across the said 100 feet of said land.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay US the sum of One Hundred and no/100 (\$100.00) ---Dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected, or if no towers are erected on said land the sum of Twenty Five and no/100 (\$25.00) shall be paid for overhang of wires the same to be paid before any wires are erected.
