County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In an easterly and westerly direction across the south 100 feet of said land

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse US for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay US the sum of One Hundred and no/100 (\$100.00) --- Dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected, or if no towers are erected on said land the sum of Twenty Five and no/100 (\$25.00) shall be paid for overhang of wires the same to be paid before any wires are erected.
