COUNTY OF OAKLAND TO DETROIT EDISON CO.

THIS INDENTURE, made this 21st day of January, A.D. 1969, by and between the County of Oakland, a Michigan Constitutional Corporation, party of the first part, and the Detroit Edison Company, a New York Corporation with its principal business office in Michigan at 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan, hereinafter referred to as "EDISON".

WITNESSETH: That said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration, to it in hand paid by EDISON, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does by these present grant to EDISON, its successors and assigns, the full and complete right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys, and guy stubs, wires and equipment, including the right to trim or cut down any trees within the Easement hereby granted which could fall into the lines or interfere with their operation.

Said Easement hereby granted shall be upon, over and across land situated in the City of Pontiac, Oakland County, Michigan, described as follows:


"The centerline of a 12 foot wide easement is described as follows: A line in the West 1/2 of Section 19, Town 3 North, Range 10 East, beginning at a point on the West line of Section 19, South 1° 55' 30" East, distant 790.7 feet from the Northwest corner of Section 19; thence South 45° 45' 30" East, for a distance of 2670.0 feet to a point; also continuing on the same line for a distance of 70 feet for guy easement; thence from said point South 58° 18' 30" West, for a distance of 1300.9 feet to a point of ending in an existing pole line."

In addition to the rights hereby granted, EDISON shall have the further right to place, where necessary, anchors and guy wires outside of said Easement.
