# SPENCER SUBSTATION EASEMENT

This General Purpose Electrical Substation Easement ("Easement Agreement"), is made and entered into this <u>27th</u> day of September, 2001, by and between Oakland University, a Michigan constitutional body corporate, whose address is Rochester, Michigan 48309-4401 ("Grantor"), and The Detroit Edison Company, a Michigan corporation, whose address is 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226, ("Grantee").

For one dollar and other good and valuable consideration receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Grantor grants to Grantee the easements described below pursuant to the following covenants, terms and conditions:

- 1. <u>Substation Easement</u>. Grantor hereby grants to Grantee an exclusive easement in gross for the limited purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining a new general-purpose electric substation ("Spencer Substation") on land owned by Grantor ("Substation Easement"). The Substation Easement shall be on a certain parcel of unimproved land owned by Grantor located in the City of Auburn Hills, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, which is more fully described in the certified surveyed legal description attached hereto as Exhibit A which is incorporated herein and made part of this Easement Agreement by this reference ("Substation Easement Area").
- 2. Access Easement. Grantor hereby grants to Grantee a non-exclusive easement in gross for the limited purpose of reasonably necessary ingress to and egress from the Substation Easement Area ("Access Easement"). The Access Easement shall be on a certain parcel of land owned by Grantor located in the City of Auburn Hills, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, which is more fully described in the certified surveyed legal description attached hereto as Exhibit B, which is incorporated herein and made part of this Easement Agreement by this reference ("Access Easement Area").

- 3. <u>Utility Easement</u>. Grantor hereby grants to Grantee a non-exclusive easement in gross for the limited purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining, underground utility line facilities consisting of wires, manholes, conduits, pipes, cables and accessories ("Utility Easement"). The Utility Easement shall be on a certain parcel of land owned by Grantor located in the City of Auburn Hills, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, which is more fully described in the certified surveyed legal description attached hereto as Exhibit C, which is incorporated herein and made part of this Easement Agreement by this reference ("Utility Easement Area").
- 4. Reservation of Rights. Grantor shall retain the right to use its fee interests in the Substation Easement Area, the Access Easement Area, and the Utility Easement Area (collectively referred to hereinafter as the "Easement Area") for any purpose not inconsistent with this Easement Agreement. Grantee shall not expand any Easement Area without the prior express written consent of Grantor evidenced by a duly executed amendment to this Easement Agreement. Grantee shall not additionally burden any Easement Area unless such additional burden is reasonably necessary and essential to Grantee's enjoyment of the respective easement area and the additional burden does not increase the burden on Grantor's fee interests, and unless Grantor has provided express written consent evidenced by a duly executed amendment to this Easement Agreement.
- 5. Successors and Assigns. This Easement Agreement may be assigned by Grantee only to an entity that will distribute electrical power to Grantor through the Substation. Grantee hereby represents and warrants to Grantor intending the Grantor to rely thereon, that Grantee will require any such assignee to enter into an assignment agreement containing the same terms and conditions as this Easement Agreement and any amendments thereto.
- 6. <u>Governing Law</u>. The laws of the State of Michigan shall govern this Easement Agreement. Grantor and Grantee shall be separately responsible for compliance with all federal, state and local laws, including nondiscrimination laws.
- 7. <u>Amendment</u>. This Easement Agreement may only be amended by a written instrument that is duly executed by Grantor and is in recordable form.
- 8. <u>Duration of Easement Agreement</u>. Grantor may terminate this Easement Agreement pursuant to the terms of the Spencer Substation at Oakland University Construction, Operation and Maintenance Agreement made by and

entered into by the Grantor and the Grantee, and upon any such termination, all rights granted by Grantor to Grantee pursuant to this Easement Agreement shall revert to Grantor.







# SPENCER SUBSTATION EASEMENT

This General Purpose Electrical Substation Easement ("Easement Agreement"), is made and entered into this <u>27th</u> day of September, 2001, by and between Oakland University, a Michigan constitutional body corporate, whose address is Rochester, Michigan 48309-4401 ("Grantor"), and The Detroit Edison Company, a Michigan corporation, whose address is 2000 Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226, ("Grantee").

For one dollar and other good and valuable consideration receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Grantor grants to Grantee the easements described below pursuant to the following covenants, terms and conditions:

- 1. <u>Substation Easement</u>. Grantor hereby grants to Grantee an exclusive easement in gross for the limited purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining a new general-purpose electric substation ("Spencer Substation") on land owned by Grantor ("Substation Easement"). The Substation Easement shall be on a certain parcel of unimproved land owned by Grantor located in the City of Auburn Hills, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, which is more fully described in the certified surveyed legal description attached hereto as Exhibit A which is incorporated herein and made part of this Easement Agreement by this reference ("Substation Easement Area").
- 2. <u>Access Easement</u>. Grantor hereby grants to Grantee a non-exclusive easement in gross for the limited purpose of reasonably necessary ingress to and egress from the Substation Easement Area ("Access Easement"). The Access Easement shall be on a certain parcel of land owned by Grantor located in the City of Auburn Hills, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, which is more fully described in the certified surveyed legal description attached hereto as Exhibit B, which is incorporated herein and made part of this Easement Agreement by this reference ("Access Easement Area").

- 3. <u>Utility Easement</u>. Grantor hereby grants to Grantee a non-exclusive easement in gross for the limited purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining, underground utility line facilities consisting of wires, manholes, conduits, pipes, cables and accessories ("Utility Easement"). The Utility Easement shall be on a certain parcel of land owned by Grantor located in the City of Auburn Hills, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, which is more fully described in the certified surveyed legal description attached hereto as Exhibit C, which is incorporated herein and made part of this Easement Agreement by this reference ("Utility Easement Area").
- 4. Reservation of Rights. Grantor shall retain the right to use its fee interests in the Substation Easement Area, the Access Easement Area, and the Utility Easement Area (collectively referred to hereinafter as the "Easement Area") for any purpose not inconsistent with this Easement Agreement. Grantee shall not expand any Easement Area without the prior express written consent of Grantor evidenced by a duly executed amendment to this Easement Agreement. Grantee shall not additionally burden any Easement Area unless such additional burden is reasonably necessary and essential to Grantee's enjoyment of the respective easement area and the additional burden does not increase the burden on Grantor's fee interests, and unless Grantor has provided express written consent evidenced by a duly executed amendment to this Easement Agreement.
- 5. <u>Successors and Assigns</u>. This Easement Agreement may be assigned by Grantee only to an entity that will distribute electrical power to Grantor through the Substation. Grantee hereby represents and warrants to Grantor intending the Grantor to rely thereon, that Grantee will require any such assignee to enter into an assignment agreement containing the same terms and conditions as this Easement Agreement and any amendments thereto.
- 6. <u>Governing Law</u>. The laws of the State of Michigan shall govern this Easement Agreement. Grantor and Grantee shall be separately responsible for compliance with all federal, state and local laws, including nondiscrimination laws.
- 7. <u>Amendment</u>. This Easement Agreement may only be amended by a written instrument that is duly executed by Grantor and is in recordable form.
- 8. <u>Duration of Easement Agreement</u>. Grantor may terminate this Easement Agreement pursuant to the terms of the Spencer Substation at Oakland University Construction, Operation and Maintenance Agreement made by and

entered into by the Grantor and the Grantee, and upon any such termination, all rights granted by Grantor to Grantee pursuant to this Easement Agreement shall revert to Grantor.

# SPENCER SUBSTATION AT OAKLAND UNIVERSITY CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT

This Spencer Substation at Oakland University Construction, Operation and Maintenance Agreement ("COM" Agreement), is made and entered into this <a href="https://example.com/27th\_day.of/

- 1. <u>Spencer Substation</u>. Detroit Edison will construct, operate, and maintain a new general-purpose substation on land owned by the University, which shall provide electric service to both the University and other customers of Detroit Edison (the "Spencer Substation"). The Spencer Substation will consist of two 24/32/40 MVA transformers (120kV/13.2kV) and related equipment.
- 2. Location. The Spencer Substation will be located approximately 600 feet east of Squirrel Road and approximately 100 feet south of Lonedale Road. The exact location of the Spencer Substation will be more fully described in a Spencer Substation Easement Agreement made by and entered into by the University and Detroit Edison on a date even herewith ("Easement Agreement"), which will contain a certified surveyed legal description of the land to be used for the Spencer Substation. Three drawings representing the general layout and general location of the Spencer Substation are attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. See Exhibits A, B, and C.
- 3. <u>Security and Clearances</u>. The University shall not construct any buildings or improvements or allow any trees or other vegetation to grow near the Spencer Substation, except as hereinafter provided, that could reasonably be expected to: (a) be used by unauthorized persons to either enter the Spencer Substation or compromise the access security of the Spencer Substation in any way, or (b) violate the electric clearances required by the 1997 version of the National Electrical Safety Code (ANCI-C2-1997) that has been adopted by the Michigan Public Service Commission ("MPSC").
- 4. Ownership of the Spencer Substation. Detroit Edison will own all the substation equipment and all incoming 120 kV, and those outgoing 13.2 kV circuits that serve other Detroit Edison customers, and none of said equipment or circuits will be considered inseverably attached to the University's land regardless of whether such equipment or circuits would be considered to be so in law but for this paragraph.
- 5. <u>Utilization of Spencer Substation to Serve the University</u>.

- 5.1. Detroit Edison shall provide the University with a circuit position in the Spencer Substation, which will be connected to the University's Switchhouse to supply the University's requirements for delivery of electric energy to serve up to 15 MVA of load, subject to scheduled and unscheduled outages.
- 5.2. Detroit Edison shall locate at its sole cost and expense a primary switch cabinet ("PSC") on a pad adjacent to the Spencer Substation, which shall provide the means of connecting the University to an alternate circuit within the Spencer Substation ("Alternate Circuit").
  - 5.2.1. Detroit Edison shall make the Alternate Circuit available to the University, if it is not then being used to serve other Detroit Edison customers and if not required for emergencies, for the University's non-emergency use to accommodate planned maintenance-related activities, and for University power outage emergencies related to failure of either the circuit position or the incoming Detroit Edison power source.
    - 5.2.2. The University understands and acknowledges that the Alternate Circuit may not be available for the University's use at all times. Therefore, the University will give Detroit Edison at least three months prior written notice of the University's intent to use the Alternate Circuit, and the period of time the University intends to use the Alternate Circuit, which shall not exceed one continuous week or two weeks in any month. Detroit Edison shall make all reasonable efforts to avoid any use of the Alternate Circuit during the time period designated by the University that would adversely affect the University's use of the Alternate Circuit.
- 6. <u>Electric Service</u>. The electric energy and distribution service or distribution service only ("Electric Service") provided to the University by Detroit Edison through the Spencer Substation is not covered by this COM Agreement and shall be pursuant to the rates and rules approved from time to time by the MPSC. Subject to the University making other arrangements with Detroit Edison to receive Electric Service at the University's expense, termination of this COM Agreement alone shall not preclude the University from receiving Electric Service from Detroit Edison pursuant to such rates and rules of the MPSC as may then be in effect.
- 7. Excess Load Capacity. This COM Agreement and the Spencer Substation will provide the University with up to 15 MVA of load capacity only. If and when the University requires load capacity in excess of 15 MVA, Detroit Edison and the University agree to explore the means and methods by which

such excess load capacity can be provided to the University by Detroit Edison. However, any such excess load capacity will be provided upon terms and conditions acceptable to both Detroit Edison and the University, which terms and conditions may or may not be similar to the terms and conditions of this COM Agreement.

### 8. Construction.

- 8.1. Detroit Edison shall, at its sole cost and expense, construct, install and/or provide the Spencer Substation, the PSC, enclosure walls and foundations (excluding the University's Switchhouse), and access roads (collectively referred to herein as the "Improvements"), as follows:
  - 8.1.1. Enclosure walls and foundations. Detroit Edison shall own the enclosure walls and foundations (excluding the University's Switchhouse) and provide reasonable and necessary maintenance upon completion of construction. Detroit Edison shall have maintenance responsibility for that portion of the high common wall extending vertically beyond the University Switchhouse, and the University shall allow Detroit Edison reasonable access for such maintenance purposes.
  - 8.1.2. Detroit Edison shall contribute \$25,000 to the University toward the cost of the landscaping. Payment shall be made within 30 days of an invoice supported by invoices from the University's contractor.
  - 8.1.3. Detroit Edison shall not be required to pay more than \$600,000 for the cost and expense of the enclosure walls and foundations, collectively.
  - 8.1.4. Access roads with gravel surfaces. Detroit Edison shall construct access roads with gravel surfaces and provide all reasonable and necessary maintenance and snow removal services for the access roads upon completion of construction. Detroit Edison shall not be required to pay more than \$50,000 for the cost and expense of constructing such access roads. An access easement area will be described in the Easement Agreement, and Detroit Edison shall maintain the access easement area in a good and useful condition.
  - 8.2. The University shall, at its sole cost and expense, construct, install and/or provide and maintain the University's

switchgear, cable and conduit from its switchgear to the circuit position and the PSC, building/enclosure ("University Switchhouse"), related equipment and landscaping including berms, trees, shrubbery and prairie grass. The University shall own all landscaping and provide reasonable and necessary maintenance, upon completion of construction.

- 8.3. The parties have independently retained or will independently retain DiClemente Siegal Design, Inc. ("DiClemente") to provide professional services for the Improvements, landscaping and the University Switchhouse but not for the Spencer Substation and PSC, including by way of example but without limitation, site planning, surveys and soil borings, preparation of preliminary design documents, architectural and engineering services, development of construction documents, development of plans and specifications, and on-site construction management services ("Professional Services"). The parties shall cooperate with each other and with DiClemente to assist DiClemente in the performance of its Professional Services. All designs, schematic or otherwise for the Improvements but not the Spencer Substation and PSC are subject to the University's prior approval.
- 8.4. Detroit Edison will enter into contract(s) (or perform with its own forces) for construction of the Improvements, and to purchase related equipment. The University will enter into a contract for construction of the University Switchhouse, to purchase related equipment and landscaping. DiClemente will act as the on-site construction manager for all construction and Improvements but not the Spencer Substation and PSC. Each party shall be responsible for obtaining any tests, inspections, approvals, rights-of-way, easements, permits, or licenses, necessary for their construction, provided however, the parties shall cooperate with each other on all such matters, and shall coordinate when possible for the retention of trade contractors. subcontractors, vendors, purchase orders, and other agreements necessary for the construction of the Improvements, the University Switchhouse and landscaping. All portions of construction are subject to the University's and Detroit Edison's prior approval, and all construction contracts shall contain insurance and indemnity provisions, guarantees and warranties, contractor and vendor selection processes, and other terms and conditions acceptable to both Detroit Edison and the University. All guarantees and warranties, if any, from all trade contractors, subcontractors and vendors shall run directly to the party holding the construction contract.

8.5. The parties intend that all Improvements and landscaping will be completed and the Spencer Substation and University Switchhouse will be fully operational no later than November 30, 2002, if all applicable permits, if any, are obtained on or before October 1, 2001.

## 9. Warranties and Environmental Indemnity.

- 9.1. Detroit Edison hereby represents and warrants to the University intending the University to rely thereon, that Detroit Edison shall construct, operate and maintain the Spencer Substation and the PSC in accordance with applicable state, federal, or local law, and that Detroit Edison shall keep the Spencer Substation and the PSC free from all pollutants, contaminants and hazardous substances as defined by applicable state, federal or local law. Detroit Edison covenants and agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold the University harmless to the maximum extent permitted by law from and against all penalties, claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses, including without limitation reasonable attorney fees, arising out of, or incurred or imposed upon the University directly or indirectly, which arise out of the location on, required removal of, or drainage or leakage from the Spencer Substation and the PSC of any such pollutant, contaminant or hazardous substance, not occasioned by the acts or omissions of the University. To the extent permitted by law the provisions of this paragraph shall survive any termination of this COM Agreement.
- 9.2. The University hereby represents and warrants to Detroit Edison intending Detroit Edison to rely thereon, that the University shall construct, operate and maintain the University Switchhouse and the landscaping in accordance with applicable state, federal, or local law, and that the University shall keep the University Switchhouse and the landscaping free from all pollutants, contaminants and hazardous substances as defined by applicable state, federal or local law. The University covenants and agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold Detroit Edison harmless to the maximum extent permitted by law from and against all penalties, claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses, including without limitation reasonable attorney fees, arising out of, or incurred or imposed upon Detroit Edison directly or indirectly, which arise out of the location on, required removal of, or drainage or leakage from the University Switchhouse and the landscaping of any such pollutant, contaminant or hazardous substance, not occasioned by the acts or omissions of Detroit Edison. To the extent permitted by law the provisions of this paragraph shall survive any termination of this COM Agreement.

# 10. <u>Indemnification</u>.

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- 10.1. Detroit Edison covenants and agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold the University, its board, officers, employees, students and volunteers, in their official and personal capacities, harmless to the maximum extent permitted by law from and against any and all claims, demands, suits, judgments, liability, loss and expense, including but not limited to claims for personal injury or death of any person or damage to any property, and legal fees, arising from the construction, operation and maintenance of the Spencer Substation that do not arise out of or are not related to the provision, or failure to provide Electric Service and/or occasioned by the acts or omissions of the University. To the extent permitted by law the provisions of this paragraph shall survive any termination of this COM Agreement.
- 10.2. The University covenants and agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold Detroit Edison, its board, officers and employees, in their official and personal capacities, harmless to the maximum extent permitted by law from and against any and all claims, demands, suits, judgments, liability, loss and expense, including but not limited to claims for personal injury or death of any person or damage to any property, and legal fees, arising from the construction, operation and maintenance of the University Switchhouse not occasioned by the acts or omissions of Detroit Edison. Nothing in this COM Agreement shall create or be deemed to create a waiver by the University of governmental immunity as established by the Michigan Governmental Tort Liability Act. To the extent permitted by law the provisions of this paragraph shall survive any termination of this COM Agreement.
- 11. <u>Events of Default and Remedies</u>. The following shall be events of default under this COM Agreement:
  - A party shall be in default hereunder if the party fails to observe and perform any covenant, condition, or agreement on its part to be observed or performed pursuant to this COM Agreement ("Default"), for a period of 90 days after written notice specifying such Default which requests that such Default be remedied has been delivered to the party in Default, provided however, if the failure stated in the notice cannot be corrected within 90 days, the other party will not unreasonably withhold its consent to an extension of such time if corrective action is instituted and diligently pursued by the party in Default within the 90 day period.

- 11.2. In the event of a Default by the University which has not been corrected, Detroit Edison shall be entitled to take whatever action at law or in equity, that may appear necessary or desirable to enforce its rights and/or performance of the applicable covenant, condition, or agreement, or to recover damages for breach thereof.
- 11.3. In the event of a Default by Detroit Edison that has not been corrected, the following remedies shall be available:
  - 11.3.1. For a Default under paragraph 5.1, the University's sole remedy shall be as follows:
    - 11.3.1.1 To terminate this COM Agreement and the Easement Agreement by written notice to Detroit Edison. The terminations shall be effective on a date selected by Detroit Edison not more than 3 years after such written notice; provided however, that from the date of said written notice to Detroit Edison and through the date of termination selected by Detroit Edison, Detroit Edison shall pay to the University in monthly installments amounts equal to the fair market value of the use of the University's land. The fair market value for the use of the land will be determined by an appraisal conducted by an independent, licensed appraiser acceptable to both parties; provided, however, that if agreement on such appraiser is not reached within 30 days of the written notice of termination, then the fair market value shall be equal to the average of the values determined by a licensed appraiser appointed by each party. Upon termination Detroit Edison will remove all of the Improvements and shall restore the University's land as nearly as possible to its original condition, and the University must make other arrangements for Electric Service with Detroit Edison at the University's expense.
  - 11.3.2. For any Default other than that covered by Section 11.3.1, the University shall be entitled to take whatever action at law or in equity, except termination or cancellation of this COM Agreement or the Easement Agreement, that may appear necessary or desirable to enforce its rights and/or performance of the applicable covenant, condition, or agreement, or to recover damages for breach thereof.

- 11.4. Neither party shall be liable to the other for any consequential. incidental, or exemplary damages, including without limitation, lost profits, or damages for the loss of electric service to the University or Detroit Edison's other customers.
- 11.5. The remedies contained herein are intended to be exclusive.
- 12. Beneficiaries. This COM Agreement is for the sole and exclusive benefit of the parties hereto and neither party intends to create a benefit in favor of any other person, entity, or third party. However, each party is the intended third-party beneficiary of the other party's contracts, subcontracts, purchase orders and other agreements between the other party and its construction contractors, subcontractors and vendors.
- 13. Adherence to State, Federal and Local Law. Detroit Edison and the University shall be separately responsible for compliance with all applicable Federal, state and local laws and regulations, including nondiscrimination laws.
- 14. Amendments. The parties may modify this COM Agreement only by written amendment signed by the parties' officers or authorized designees. Only the President, or Vice President for Finance and Administration has the authority to act on behalf of the University to modify this COM Agreement.
- 15. Force Majeure. Neither party shall have any liability for delays, failure in performance or damages affecting any of the parties or their respective suppliers or contractors due to: fire, explosion, strikes or labor disputes, water, acts of God, the elements, war, civil disturbances, acts of civil or military authorities or the public enemy, inability to secure raw materials, transportation facilities, equipment failures, or other causes beyond the party's reasonable control whether or not similar to the foregoing.
- 16. Assignment.
  - 16.1. Detroit Edison may assign this COM Agreement without the University's consent only to an entity that will provide electrical distribution service to the University through the Spencer Substation. Detroit Edison hereby represents and warrants to the University intending the University to rely thereon that Detroit Edison will require any such assignee to enter into an assignment agreement containing the same terms and conditions as this COM Agreement and any amendments thereto.

- 16.2. Except as provided in Section 16.1, neither party may assign this COM Agreement without the express prior written approval of the other party, which approval shall not be unreasonably withheld.
- 17. <u>Severability</u>. The terms of this COM Agreement are severable such that if any term or provision is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, void, or unenforceable, the remaining terms and provisions shall continue to be valid, enforceable, and in full force and effect.
- 18. <u>Waiver</u>. The failure or delay of any party to exercise any of its rights under this COM Agreement for a breach thereof shall not be deemed to be a waiver of such rights, nor shall the same be deemed to be a waiver of any subsequent breach, either of the same provision or otherwise.
- 19. <u>Headings</u>. All headings, which are used in this COM Agreement, are for the convenience of the reader only and shall not be used to limit or construe any of the provisions hereof.
- 20. <u>Applicable Laws</u>. The local laws of the State of Michigan shall govern this Agreement.
- 21. <u>Drafting</u>. This COM Agreement is the product of negotiation and neither party shall be deemed to be the drafter of this COM Agreement or any portion thereof.
- 22. <u>Applicable Agreements</u>. This COM Agreement and the Spencer Substation Easement Agreement are the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the Spencer Substation and the University Switchhouse and supercede all prior written or oral agreements understandings or communications between the parties.


