Attached for the General Files is a fully executed copy of the Permit No. 336 under Master Agreement dated January 2, 1932, (Right of Way File No. 9064) covering our crossing over tracks of the Grand Trunk Western Railroad Company at a point approximately 1670 feet North of South Boulevard, City of Pontiac, Pontiac Township, Oakland County, Michigan.

The installation consists of our 120 KV steel tower transmission line (known as our St. Clair-Bloomfield Line) as shown on our Plan RX-3382.

The permit, dated November 1, 1958, calls for the sum of \$25.00 for the first year and an annual rental of \$10.00, thereafter.

Overhead wire crossings covered by Permit No. 187 dated April 16, 1949 and Permit No. 336 dated November 1, 1958 under the Master Agreement dated January 2, 1932 have been cancelled effective August 29, 1985.

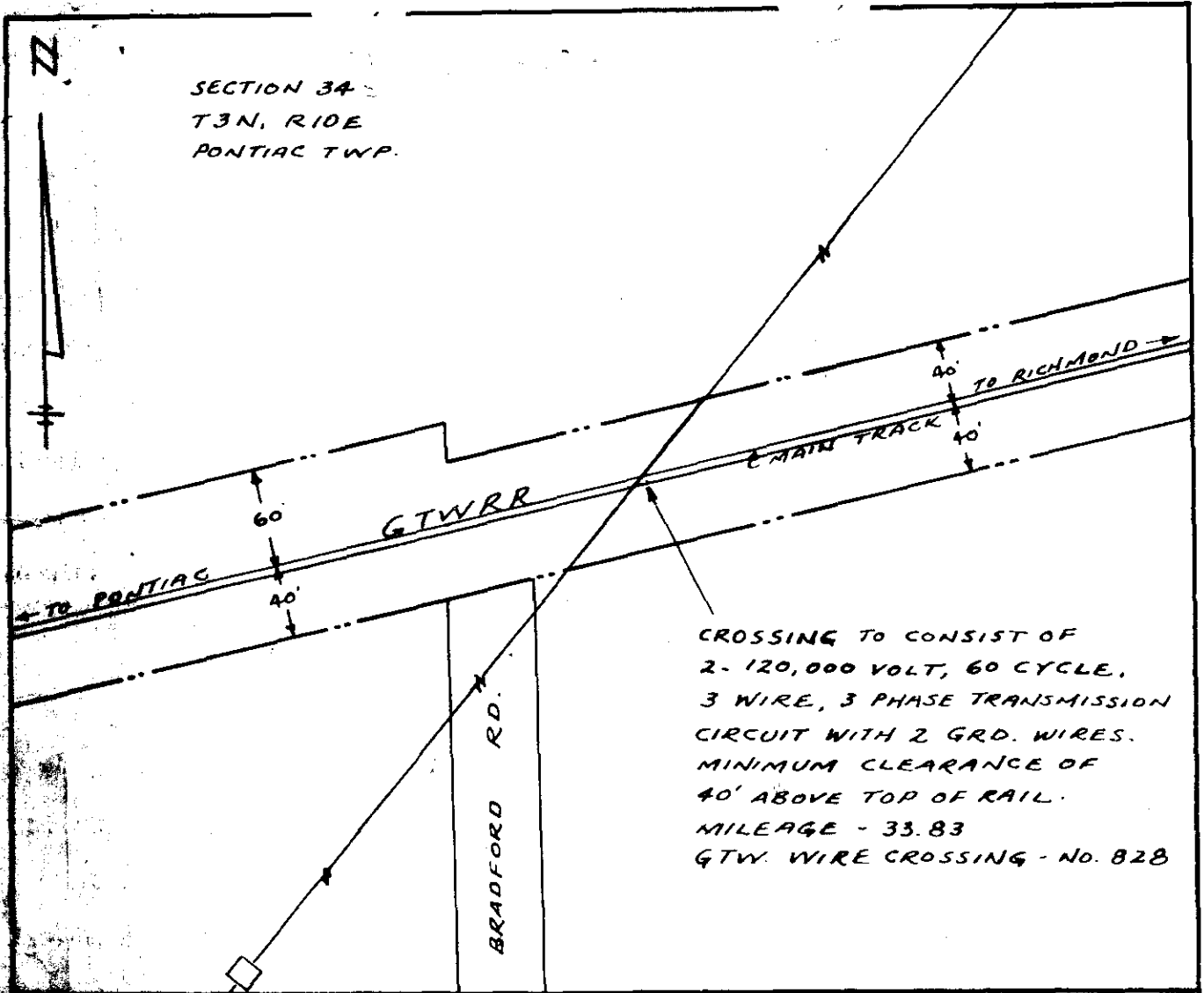
