IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned hereby grants to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across the undersigned's property located in Village of Rochester

County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

A parcel of land located in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 10, T3N, R11E, beginning at a point on the Southwesterly line of the N.Y.C. R.R.
