operation upon, over and across OUT property located in Highland Township

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

STREET AND VILLAGE OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

That part of the NE 1/4 of Sec 1 T3N, R2E, lying south of the White Lake Rd.
