IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in Highland Township

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: Part of the NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Section 2, T 3 N, R 7 E, described as beginning at a point located South 89 degrees, 54 minutes, East 843.76 feet and South 0 degrees, 25 minutes, 30 seconds West 1109.92 feet from the center Section 2; thence South 0 degrees 25 minutes 30 seconds West 70 feet; thence North 89 degrees 09 minutes 30 seconds West 115.42 feet; thence North 0 degrees 25 minutes 30 seconds East 70 feet; thence South 89 degrees 09 minutes 30 seconds East 115.42 feet to the beginning; the Westerly 10 feet thereof to be used for road purposes, also the right of ingress and egress over a strip of land 10 feet wide, the Southern ~~lines~~ lines of which are described as beginning at SW corner of above parcel; thence South 0 degrees 25 minutes 30 seconds East 150 feet; thence South 89 degrees 09 minutes 30 seconds East 102.74 feet to the center line of White Lake Road. Containing 0.169 acres.

The route of the lines shall be as follows:

In a northeasterly and southwesterly direction across said land along approximately 230 feet north of and parallel to White Lake Road so called.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Five & 20/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
