

POLE LINE PERMIT

Date Sept 9, 1950

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in the Township of Highland, County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

Two parcels of land described as follows: That part of the Southwest 3/4 of the East 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 lying West of the Pere Marquette Railroad (now Chesapeake and Ohio Railroad) Right-of-Way except the North 1 acre and that part of the South 3/4 of the East 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 lying East of the Pere Marquette Railroad (now Chesapeake and Ohio Railroad) Right-of-Way in Section 15, T3N, R7E, Highland Township.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Across above described properties from North to South and 5 feet more or less, West of and parallel to the Pere Marquette Railroad (Now Chesapeake and Ohio Railroad) Right-of-way.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Five and no/100--(\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
