

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Mr hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in Township of Highland County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

Part of NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 Bog on N line of PM RR (now Cr ORR) R/W 440 ft N of N 1/8 line, th N to E of Highland - Melford Rd, th N along said E to S line of "Original Plat of Village of Highland," th E along said S line to W line of PM RR (now Cr ORR) R/W, th S to point of beginning Sec 27, T37N, R7E containing 3.5 acres ±
The route of the lines shall be as follows:

Across above described property, in a northerly + westerly direction and 5 ft ± West of an parallel to the N line of PM RR (now Cr ORR) Right of way also in an easterly and westerly direction along and adjacent to the north line thereof.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings, fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Five + 2/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
