

IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation upon, over and across our property located in Township of Highland

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: A parcel of land in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, T3N, R7E, beginning at a point distant S. 89° 49' West 100 ft. from the Southwest corner of Adams Grove Subdivision, thence South 89° 49' West 424 ft., thence North 0° 51' 10" East 200.03 ft., thence North 89° 49' East 419.12 ft., thence South 0° 35' East 200.0 ft. to the point of beginning, also a parcel of land in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, T3N, R7E, described as follows; beginning at a point distant South 89° 49' West 100 ft. and North 0° 35' West 200 ft. from the Southwest corner of Adams Grove Sub. thence South 89° 49' West 419.12 ft., thence North 0° 51' 10" East 200.03 ft.; thence North 89° 49' East 414.10 ft. thence South 0° 35' East 200 ft. to the point of beginning.

The route of the lines shall be as follows:

Across above described land in a northerly and easterly direction, within 5 ft. West of and parallel to the P.M.R.R. (now the C.O.P.R.) Right of Way

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Five hundred (\$500) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
