"Grantor's Land" is in the Township of Highland, Oakland County, described as:

Part of Northwest one-quarter (1/4) of Southeast one-quarter (1/4) Town 3 North, Range 7 East, Section 2. beginning at point distant South 89°54'00" East 338.32 feet and South 00°25'30" West 1083.52 feet from center of section, thence South 89°09'30" East 270 feet, thence South 00°25'30" West 75 feet, thence North 89°09'30" West 270 feet, thence North 00°25'30" East 75 feet to beginning, containing approximately 0.46 acres, more or less, Oakland County Records. Sidwell No. 11-02-401-005.

The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as:

The East Ten (10) feet of Grantor's land.

- 1. Purpose: The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain overhead utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, cables, transformers and accessories.
- 2. Access: Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area.
- 3. Building or other Permanent Structures: No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's prior written consent.
- 4. Trees, Bushes, Branches or Roots: Grantee may trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches or roots in the Right of Way Area (or that could grow into the Right of Way Area) that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities.
- 5. Restoration: If Grantee's employees, contractors, vehicles or equipment damage Grantor's Land while entering Grantor's Land for the purposes stated in this Right of Way, then Grantee shall restore Grantor's Land as nearly as can be to its original condition.
- 6. Successors: This Right of Way runs with the land and binds and benefits Grantor's and Grantee's successors, lessees, licensees and assigns.
