## The "Right of Way Area" is a part of Grantor's Land and is described as:

Width of Right of Way is twelve (12) and ten (10) feet.

- 1. **Purpose:** The purpose of this Right of Way is to construct, reconstruct, modify, add to, operate and maintain overhead and underground utility line facilities consisting of poles, guys, anchors, wires, manholes, conduits, pipes, cables, transformers and accessories.
- 2. Access: Grantee has the right of access to and from the Right of Way Area and no further access is granted hereunder.
- 3. Buildings or other Permanent Structures: No buildings or other permanent structures shall be placed in the Right of Way Area without Grantee's written prior consent, provided however that Grantee shall give its consent within thirty (30) days of request if such buildings or structures shall not overlie any underground facilities.
- 4. Excavation: As required by Public Act 33 of 1974, MISS DIG must be called on 1-800-482-7171 before anyone excavates in the Right of Way Area.
- 5. Trees, Bushes, Branches, Roots, Structures and Fences: Grantee may (a) trim, cut down, remove or otherwise control any trees, bushes, branches and roots in the Right of Way Area (or upon prior written notice to Grantor, that could grow into the Right of Way Area), and (b) except for structures for which Grantee's consent has been given pursuant to Paragraph 3 hereof, remove structures and fences in the Right of Way Area that Grantee believes could interfere with the safe and reliable construction, operation and maintenance of Grantee's facilities. No trees, plant life, structures and fences shall be planted, grown or installed in the Right of Way Area within 8 feet of the front door and within 2 feet of the other sides of transformers and switching cabinet closures. Grantee shall not be responsible to Grantor for damages to or removal of trees, plant life, structures and fences placed in such area and in front of transformer doors.
