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IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations receipt of which is hereby acknowledged we hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least 8 1/2 feet, upon, over and across out

property located in Township of Highland County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

That part of the south half of the north west quarter of Section 1 lying north of the White Lake Road bounded east by C. E. Roselle and west by Harry H. Knapp, containing thirty-two acres, more or less.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a north easterly and south westerly direction across said land

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.
