IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their

operation upon over and across our property located in Township of Highland

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: That part of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 2, T3N, R9E, described as beginning at a point of the center Section 2, thence proceeding South 0° 25' 30" West 1319.14 ft. along the North and South 1/4 line to a point, thence South 89° 09' 30" East 338.30 ft. thence North 0° 25' 30" West 1323.52 ft. to the East and W. 1/4 line, thence North 89° 54' West 338.32 ft. to the point of beginning. Containing 10.26 acres more or less.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: 175 feet more or less North of and parallel to the centerline of the highway known as White Lake Road, across above described property.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Five & no/100 (\$5.00) Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
