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Agreement, Made and entered into this 26th day of February

A.D. 1917, by and between Elizabeth Haddrill of Cass County, Michigan, first party, and EASTERN MICHIGAN EDISON COMPANY, a Corporation, second party.

WITNESSETH:

In consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) dollar, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, first party, her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, hereby grants unto said second party, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate, and maintain, during the corporate existence of said second party, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, towers, wires, and fixtures upon, over, and across the property which she own, or in which she have an interest, in the Village of Oshtemo County of Oakland, and State of Michigan, the route of said line being as follows: **Said line to cross said lot, which is described as part of the East half of the North-east quarter of Section Eleven (11), at the near where said party of the first part shall designate.**

Second party shall have the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, and shall have the right to trim any trees along said lines so as to keep the wires clear at least Four (4) feet, to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors, and to attach thereto the necessary guy wires.

Second party agrees to reimburse said first party, her heirs and assigns, for all damages to her growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.
