In Consideration

of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grant permission to **The Detroit Edison Company**, its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least six feet, upon, over and across our property located in Section 27

County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: West 1/2 of the S.E. 1/4 of Sec 27
S. 5. N. R. 11. E.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a Southeasterly direction from the Northwest corner of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 28 to a point approximately 20 rods West of Lakeville Romeo Road, on South property line.

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.
