IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, WE hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their

operation upon, over and across OUR property located in BRANDON TOWNSHIP
STREET AND VILLAGE OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of OAKLAND State of Michigan, and described as follows:

THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SE 1/4 OF SECTION 16 T 5N R 9E
EXCEPT THE WEST 335.08 FEET OF THE EAST 915.38 FEET
OF THE SOUTH 130 FEET THEREOF. 79.0 ACRES

The route of the lines shall be as follows: ANCHOR GUY TO BE INSTALLED APPROXIMATELY
25 FEET NORTH OF MICHIGAN ASSOCIATED TELEPHONE COMPANY POLE
NORTH OF HIGHWAY AT SOUTH SIDE OF SAID LAND APPROXIMATELY 20
RODS EAST OF THE WEST LINE OF SAID LAND.

The Company shall reimburse US for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property for the purpose set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay US the sum of FIVE AND 100/100 Dollars for ABOVE RIGHT OF WAY on said land, the same to be paid before any ANCHOR IS INSTALLED.
