IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across our property located in S. 1/2 of Section 19, T.5 N., R.9 E.

STREET AND VILLAGE, OR SECTION AND TOWNSHIP

County of Oakland, State of Michigan, and described as follows:

Lots #218 through #254 inclusive of "Belle-Ann Falls Estates #2", a subdivision of part of lot #80 of Belle-Ann Falls Estates of part of the S. 1/2 of said Section 19. "Belle-Ann Falls Estates #2" is recorded in Liber 62 of Plats on page 28 and Belle-Ann Falls Estates is recorded in Liber 60 of Plats on page 11, Oakland County records.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a N'ly and S'ly direction across lots #218 through #236, inclusive, in a line nearly parallel to and approximately 140 ft. W'ly of E'ly lot line of each; also in a N'ly and S'ly direction across lots #237 through #254, inclusive, in a line nearly parallel to and approximately 4 ft. W'ly of the E'ly lot line of each; also in an E'ly and W'ly direction across lots #236 and #237 in a line nearly parallel to and approximately 4 ft. N'ly of the S'ly lot line of each. It is understood that the pole line across said lots #237 through #254 inclusive, can be used to furnish electric service to lots in said "Belle-Ann Falls Estates" adjoining lots #237 through #254, inclusive.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse _____ for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men, teams, trucks and other vehicles and equipment in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.
