IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, THE EDISON ILLUMINATING COMPANY OF DETROIT, a Michigan corporation, hereby grants permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, and its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain underground and overhead lines for the transmission and distribution of electricity and Company communication facilities, including the necessary towers, poles, conduits, manholes, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over, under and across its property located in the Village of Ortonville, County of Oakland and State of Michigan, more particularly described as:

An easement over the southwesterly 35 feet of Lot 6 of "Assessor's Plat No. 2," part of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 7, Town 5 North, Range 9 East, Village of Ortonville, Oakland County, Michigan, as recorded in Liber 53 of Plats, page 27, Oakland County Records, extending southeasterly from the south line of Oakwood Road to the north line of Lot 37 and Lot 30 of said "Assessor's Plat No. 2."

THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse THE EDISON ILLUMINATING COMPANY OF DETROIT, or its successors and assigns, for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

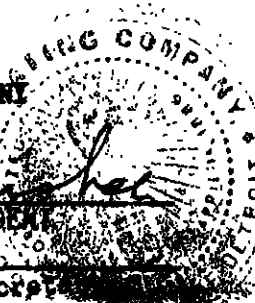
