In Consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant permission to The Detroit Edison Company, its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, wires and equipment, and the right to trim any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least 5 feet feet, upon, over and across our property located in Village of Ortonville Street and Village or Section and Township County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: Property as shown as Ortonville Baptist Church Cemetery bounded north by St. Anthony St., east by South Street and west by property of Sherburne, being lots #23 and 24 original plat of Ortonville

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In a northerly and southerly direction across said property approximately 175 feet more or less west of South Street

The Company shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company shall pay us the sum of Two and 00/100 Dollars for each pole on said land, the same to be paid before any poles are erected.
