IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, We hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, and its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, lines for electric light and power, including the necessary towers, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across own property located in the Township of Brandon County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows:

The east half of the southwest quarter and the north half of the southeast quarter, all in section fifteen (15) Township five (5) north of range nine (9) east.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Along, south of and adjacent to the north line of said land.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected.

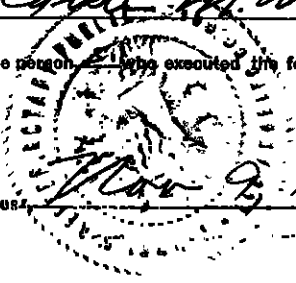
