PARTIAL RELEASE OF RIGHT OF WAY

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged EDISON does, by these presents, expressly release and abandon unto OMNER their successors and assigns, all of the rights acquired by it by virtue of the aforementioned right of way over said premises last described above. In all other respects, except as partially released herein, said Right of Way Grant dated August 2, 1929, shall remain in full force and effect.
