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IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations receipt of which is hereby acknowledged we hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, its lines for electric light and power, including the necessary poles, fixtures, guys and guy stubs, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut any trees along said lines, so as to keep the wires clear by at least eight (8) feet, upon, over and across

property located in Township of Brandon  
County of Oakland State of Michigan and described as follows: The east half of the southeast quarter of Section 31  
T 5 N, R 9 E.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Along, north of and parallel to the north fence line of the highway running along the south side of said land as now staked.

The Company shall reimburse owner for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property from time to time for the purposes set forth herein.

Upon thirty days written notice, the Company shall make such changes and alterations in the said lines as shall be necessary at the time to avoid interference with any improvements or buildings in course of erection on said property.
