IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations,

receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, and its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, lines for electric light and power, including the necessary towers, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across our property located in Brandon Township County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: The West half of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 20, T.5N, R.9E.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: Beginning at approximately the Southwest corner of said land, thence northeasterly across said land to a point on the east line of said land approximately forty (40) rods, more or less, south of the north line of section 20.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

In addition to the above consideration, the Company, or its successors and assigns, shall pay us the sum of (50.00) Fifty and 00/100 Dollars for each tower on said land, the same to be paid before any towers are erected.

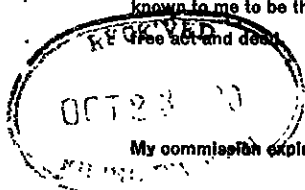

RELEASE OF RIGHT OF WAY

THIS INDENTURE, made this 20th day of July, 1972,  
between THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, a corporation organized and existing con-  
currently under the laws of the states of Michigan and New York, of 2000  
Second Avenue, Detroit, Michigan 48226, hereinafter referred to as "EDISON,"  
and ALBERTA BARBEAU, of Brandon Township, Oakland County, Michigan,  
hereinafter referred to as "OWNER."

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, on November 4, 1929, Robert B. Leece and Frances  
Leece, his wife, granted to EDISON a Right of Way for the purpose of constructing,  
operating and maintaining its lines for electric light and power over and  
upon premises in the Township of Brandon, Oakland County, Michigan, described  
as:

The West 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast  
1/4 of Section 20, Town 5 North, Range 9 East

which Right of Way is recorded in Liber 28 of Miscellaneous Records, Page 526.

WHEREAS, OWNER purports to have succeeded to the title to the  
premises described above; and

WHEREAS, OWNER has requested that EDISON release the said Right  
of Way Grant dated November 4, 1929 and EDISON is willing to do so.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00)  
and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,  
EDISON does, by these presents, expressly release, quit claim and abandon  
unto OWNER, her successors and assigns and heirs, all of the rights acquired  
by it by virtue of the aforementioned Right of Way Grant dated November 4, 1929.

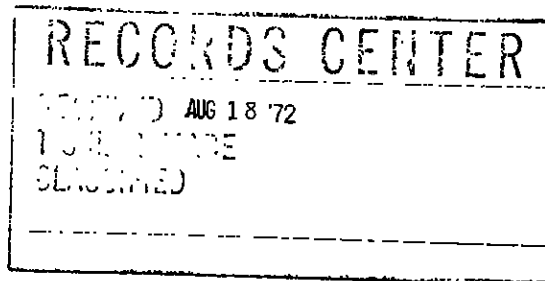
