IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, and its successors and assigns, to construct, operate and maintain during its corporate life, lines for electric light and power, including the necessary towers, fixtures, wires and equipment, and including also the right to trim or cut down any trees along said lines, which could fall into the lines or interfere in any way with their operation, upon, over and across our property located in Brandon Township County of Oakland State of Michigan, and described as follows: The southeast quarter of the northwest quarter and the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter all in Section 14, T 5 N, R 9 E.

The route of the lines shall be as follows: In an easterly and westerly direction along and adjacent to the east and west quarter line of said Section 14.

The Company, its successors and assigns, shall reimburse US for all damage to growing crops, buildings or fences, caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.

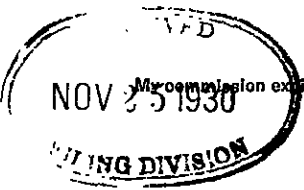
