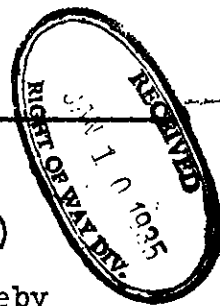

and other valuable considerations, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged we hereby grant permission to THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY, its successors and assigns, to cut trees and brush across our property located in the Township of Brandon County of Oakland and State of Michigan, to-wit:

The south ahlf of the northwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter all in section thirteen (13), Township five (5) north of range nine (9) east.

Permission is hereby granted to cut down all trees in a four rod strip and such other trees outside of said strip that are tall enough to fall into the lines of The Detroit Edison Company along and adjacent to the south line of said land.

~~THE DETROIT EDISON COMPANY AGREES TO CUT SUCH TREES INTO BRUSH OR TO~~
~~REMOVE SUCH TREES FROM THE PROPERTY.~~ The Detroit Edison Co. agrees to pay the undersigned \$450.00 for trees cut and the undersigned agrees to bear any expense in repairing fences.

The Company and its successors and assigns shall reimburse us for all damage to growing crops, buildings ~~and other property~~ caused by its men and teams and trucks in entering said property for the purposes set forth herein.
