Township. of ... Moltke ... County of ... Presque Isle ... and State of Michigan, to-wit: The South one-half  $(\frac{1}{2})$  of the Northwest one-quarter  $(\frac{1}{4})$  of Section sixteen (16), and the Northwest one-quarter  $(\frac{1}{4})$  of the Southeast one-quarter (1) of Section sixteen (16), being all in Township thirty-five (35) North, Range four (4) East. The route to be taken by said lines of XONESK, poles, wires, cables and conduits across, over and under said land being more specifically described as follows: Second party may locate said route on, over and across said above described land, along or adjoining as near as practicable a line, which said line is described as beginning at a point not more than 2000 feet nor less than 1400 feet West of the East line of Section 8, Township 35 North, Range 4 East, at a point not more than 400 feet North of the South line of said Section, running thence Southeasterly to a point not more than 100 feet West of the North and South quarter line of Section 16 of said Township, at a point not more than 600 feet nor less than 300 feet South of the East and West quarter line of said Section, running thence Southeasterly to a point not more than 1200 feet nor less than 800 feet West of the East line of Section 15 of said Township at a point not more than 600 feet nor less than 400 feet North of the South line of said Section 15.
