Written assignment

Required THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 17th day of December, 1940, by and between THE ANN ARBOR RAILROAD COMPANY and NORMAN B. FITCAIRN AND FRANK C. NICODEMUS, JR., Receivers thereof, parties of the first part (hereinafter collectively called the Railroad), and CONSUMERS POWER COMPANY, of Jackson, Michigan, party of the second part (hereinafter called the Company),

WITNESSETH: That, for and in consideration of an initial sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and the further sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) annually, in advance, to be paid by the Company to the Railroad, and the covenants, agreements and undertakings of the Company hereinafter contained, the Railroad hereby grants unto the Company the license and permission to construct and thereafter maintain an overhead transmission line, consisting of three 336400 C.M. A.C.S.R. wires, carrying 140,000 volts, and two 3/8" galvanized steel ground wires, and appurtenances, over and across the Railroad's right of way at a point approximately 160 feet south of Mile Post Toledo 82, North of Howell, Michigan, as shown in brown line on the print dated December 3, 1940, attached hereto and hereby made a part of this agreement.

First: The construction must be in accordance with state laws and local ordinances, and comply with the rules of the Michigan Public Service Commission, and in accordance with details shown on prints marked X-10982 attached hereto.

Second: Before beginning any work in connection with the said transmission line, insofar as it will affect the property, equipment or operation of the Railroad, the Superintendent of Telegraph of the Railroad shall be notified, in order that he may be present in person or by a representative to see that the material and work meet with the approval of the Railroad.

Third: The Company shall not increase the voltage, or construct additional wires, other than as specified herein, without the written consent of the Railroad.

Fourth: If the operation or maintenance of the transmission line should at any time cause interference with or damage to the Railroad's telegraph, telephone or signal wires or appurtenances, the Company agrees to make such changes, at its own cost and expense, as may be necessary to eliminate such interference or damage, and to reimburse the Railroad for any expense incurred on account of such interference or damage.

Fifth: In the event that the Railroad shall at any time or times in the future desire or be required to change the grade or location of the railroad tracks, wires, poles and appurtenances owned or used by the Railroad, and/or to make any addition thereto, the Company agrees that, upon the written request of the Railroad, it will make such changes in the said transmission line as may be necessary to provide proper clearance and eliminate any interference with or damage to the Railroad's telegraph, telephone or signal wires or appurtenances. If the Company shall fail to comply with any such request within ten (10) days, the Railroad shall have the right to make such changes at the risk and expense of the Company.

Sixth: As a part of the consideration for the grant herein

made to it by the Railroad, the Company covenants and agrees that it will save the Railroad harmless from and indemnify it against any and all losses, damages, recoveries, costs and expenses for injury to or death of any person or persons whomsoever, or loss or destruction of, or damage to any property whatsoever (including both parties hereto and their employes and property), arising from or growing out of, directly or indirectly, the construction, existence, operation or maintenance of said transmission line across the right of way of the Railroad, or its removal therefrom, the risk of which is assumed by the Company, unless caused by the sole negligence of the Railroad, its agents or servants.

Seventh: The Company shall not sublet, assign or transfer its facilities, covered by this agreement, without the written consent of the Railroad.

Eighth: This agreement shall take effect on the date hereof and continue in full force until terminated by either party giving to the other sixty (60) days' notice in writing of its intention to terminate the same, and the Company covenants and agrees that it will, within the said sixty (60) day period fixed in said notice, remove its property from the right of way of the Railroad; the provisions of this agreement to remain in full force and effect until such removal has been made.

This agreement binds the Receivers only during the term of their Receivership.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, The parties hereto have caused this agreement to be executed in duplicate by their respective proper officers thereunto duly authorized, the day and year first above written.


